JUNKO Tabei



Junko Tabei was the first female ever to reach the peak of Mount Everest. During her accomplishment in 1975, Junko and her guides were buried under the snow when an avalanche struck their camp. She lost consciousness for about 6 minutes before her Sherpa guide dug her out. She didn't give up and successfully reached the peak 12 days later.



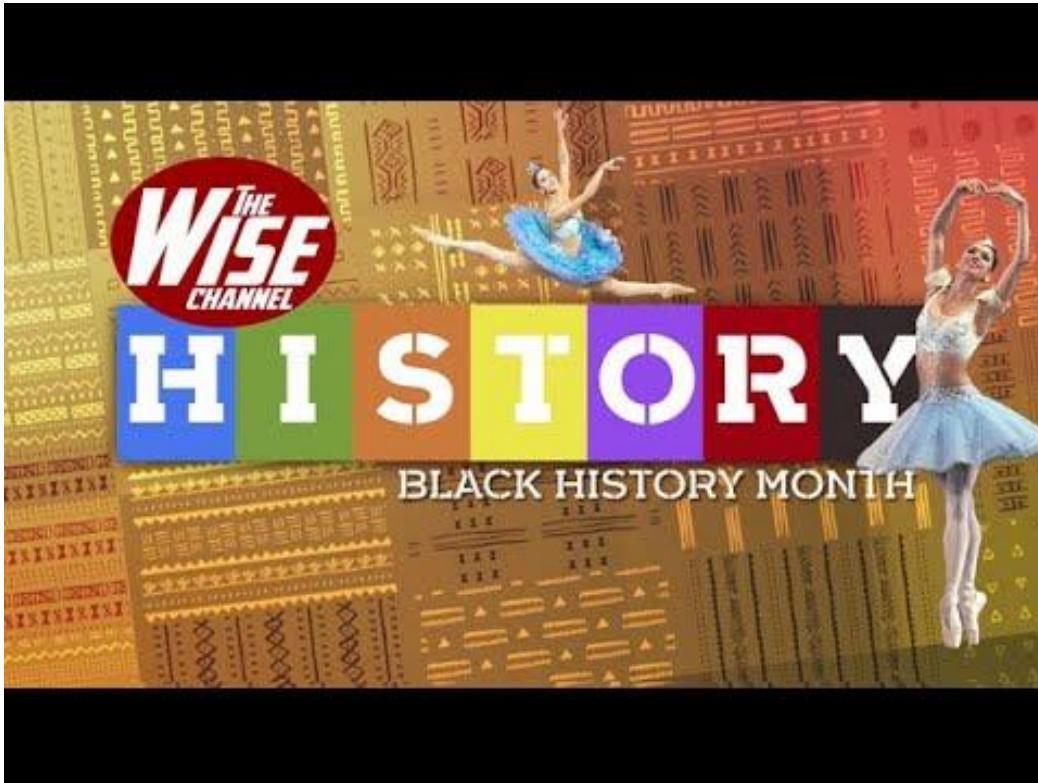
KAMALA HARRIS



Kamala Harris is a lawyer and politician. In 2016, she was elected and served as the first Indian American senator in the United States. In 2020, she became the first black, Indian American, and woman to be elected as vice president of the United States.



MISTY COPELAND



Misty Copeland became the first African American female principal dancer with the American Ballet Theatre in 2015. She is an author, and wrote a children's book called, *Firebird*. Misty also works to provide youth with dance programs in developing countries.

SARAH BREEDLOVE

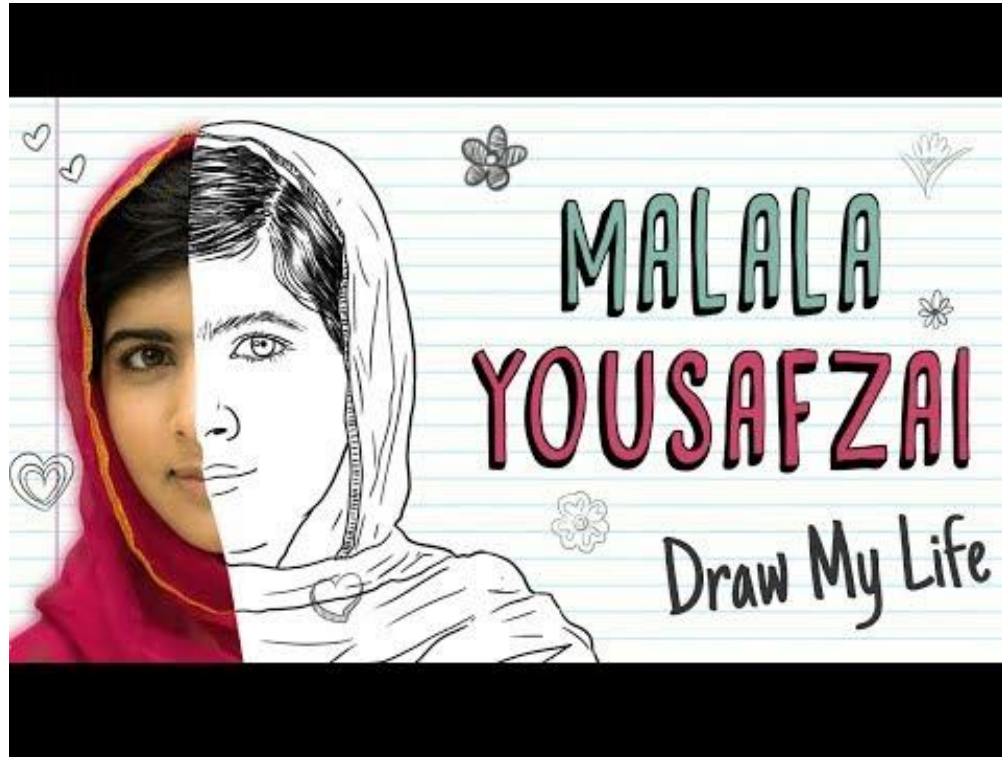

Sarah Breedlove was an American entrepreneur and philanthropist. She was said to be the first female self-made millionaire in America. She became famous by developing and marketing a successful line of beauty and hair products for black women after she suffered with her own hair loss.



MALALA YOUSAFZAI



Malala Yousafzai is a female education activist who spoke out for equal education rights for young girls. As a young girl, Malala would sneak to school in order to receive an education. One day on her way home, the Taliban, a group of dangerous men, found her and shot her three times. Malala was rushed to a hospital where she was thankfully saved. Malala won the Nobel Peace Prize in 2014 and is currently an author and shares her mission with others around the world.



RUTH BADER GINSBURG



Ruth Bader Ginsburg was the second woman ever to serve as a justice on the U.S. Supreme Court. She fought fiercely for women's rights, for herself, and others. Before serving, Ruth worked as an advocate for the advancement of gender equality. She worked as a volunteer attorney for the American Civil Liberties Union, which was established to defend the rights guaranteed to every person in the United States. Ruth served on the Supreme court for 27 years before she passed away in 2020.



MICHELLE OBAMA



Michelle Obama is an attorney and author who is best known for being the first African American first lady of the United States. In 2010 she launched the “Let’s Move! Campaign, which worked towards fighting obesity in children. She continues to work as a spokesperson for ensuring children have good nutrition and exercise habits. On March 16, 2021 she will premiere a new culinary tv show for kids on Netflix called Waffles + Mochi, where she will cook, explore, and eat food from around the world.
