Approval of Minutes

Constituent Services Policy – N. Carr

The Committee and Sharon agreed to reach out to the Council of Great City Schools (CGCS) about utilizing them to facilitate a Board member training.

NCSBA Policy Services Update - N. Carr

GCS staff is sending the NCSBA a flash drive containing current GCS policies for the custom policy manual conversion process.

The Committee agreed to have the NCSBA begin the conversion process by reviewing Section J – Students policies first. Note: As part of the custom manual conversion process, GCS policies and procedures will be issued new names that correspond with the NCSBA's naming convention. The current GCS "Section J – Students" polices will become "Students – 4000."

- GCS staff will send the NCSBA a flash drive containing current GCS policies and procedures.
- Nora Carr will advise the NCSBA to begin the policy conversion process with Section J Students
 policies.
