_____ Your instrument (in proper working order) Although the choice is ultimately yours, I suggest researching a rent to own policy at one of your local music stores. These programs often offer repair to your instrument for no additional cost. If you purchase a used instrument, please have it looked over by a reputable repairman before bringing it to class to insure it is in good working order. I have provided a few names of reputable repair technicians in the county. Special note to brass players: tuning slides should be free and easily movable.

_____ Music book, **Essential Elements bk. 1** (be sure to purchase a book for **your** instrument)

_____ Concert Attire: Purple Northern Music Shirt, Black Belt, Black Business Pants, Black Socks, Black Business Shoes (we will order shirts at the beginning of the year)

_____ Permanent name tag for your instrument case (a luggage tag works well)
