Copies of the March meeting minutes were reviewed and approved.

Old Business

SLT had no old business to discuss.

New Business

FFA Bell Schedule was reviewed and discussed. Same as years passed, approved. Concern about low attendance 3rd block, kids need to be in the classroom following schedule not lingering out at FFA day.

Suggestion made for future discussion on what changing a schedule would look like to change to a yearlong school and would affect other programs.

Scott requested list of concerns of 22 credits to graduate. Dobbins requested how much money is going to CCP program?

Field Trips policy/Missing class time was looked at regarding missing curriculum time. Optional field trips conversation about what missing and need to make up. Five-day email helps with discussion with the kids as well. Kids missing for sports multiple times as week. Trying to push back times, so the kids have max time in the classroom. Teachers need to reach out to coaches if struggling to attend learning hub. Discussion around sports times brought up.

NO field trips after April 1 that are non-competitive needs to be approved by SLT. Revisit to update for review to add in policy a number of day rule to make up work like attendance policy.

AP teachers expressed concern because kids have other activities and can not go to exam reviews.

Next meeting discusses issues around events and conflict AP classes.

Media wanted to see if book Anthropocene Reviewed by John Green can be approved for Fike's class that is not on approved reading list. SLT Committee approved

Discipline issues cannot find the kids sometime. Admin are working on a system and will keep communication with staff.

Parking of kid in wrong spot, take a picture and send to administration so they can see who the kid is. Parking will be different next year. Staff will have parking pass on their cars next year.
