## SEHS SLT Minutes 12.6.2022

The meeting commenced at **8:15am** in room 100.

Copies of the November meeting minutes were reviewed and approved.

## **Old Business**

The Teacher Working Conditions Survey Subcommittee analyzed the mid-cycle survey and presented <u>results</u>. The committee shared that the results did not give them any clear next steps so administration requested a full report of the results so they can review them to hopefully pinpoint next steps.

## **New Business**

Several departments raised concerns over the field trip policy specifically around timely communication around which students who are participating. SLT reviewed the <u>Field Trip Policy</u> (see page 29-30) and made a few adjustments:

- the entire school will receive notification 5 days prior to the field trip at which point, Dabbs will input the student's attendance as a school sponsored event
- return time is now 4:15pm since we dismiss at 4:25

SLT discussed concerns over the remote asynchronous dates set for Feb 8 (MAP testing), March 7 (ACT testing) and April 19 (MAP testing). With concerns over the lost instructional time, it was clarified that unlike inclement weather day, these remote asynchronous days can/should provide new content to students as well as assign work that can be due these three days. Additionally, SLT discussed concerns over the testing kids actually not showing these days. In response, SLT agreed to evaluate tester attendance on February 8<sup>th</sup>. If tester attendance is poor, we will re-evaluate future asynchronous days.

The schools Media and Technology Advisory Committee is the SLT. MTAC is responsible for reviewing and approving the use of novels not already on the GCS approved reading list. MTAC was asked to approve *This Tender Land* and *Jamaica Inn.* MTAC/SLT approved the use of these two books at Southeast.
