**Old Business**

Jamie Davis shared an update on progress towards meeting our school improvement goals. Math 1 met their SIP goal, Math 3 exceeded their SIP goal, and Biology exceeded their goal as well. SLT agreed that our MTSS indicator for February would be A3.10 All teachers use assessment data to match their instruction and supports to individual student needs. Teachers meet in their PLCs to review assessment data and plan for corrective instruction based on student needs. Additionally, teachers use the data to plan for spiraling, tutorials and ELP.

SLT voted to change the way 1<sup>st</sup> block tardy referrals are handled. While students who are tardy to first block will continue to get their note from Mrs. Baker, all referrals will be handled by the teacher effective immediately.

Mrs. Colson shared an update about upcoming registration which begins February 24 during 2<sup>nd</sup> block. Counselors will meet individually with students to select their courses for next year. Counselors will be holding a rising freshmen parent night February 17 at the middle school.

There was discussion about hosting a Curriculum Fair for rising 9<sup>th</sup> grade parents. This would need to accompany the February 17<sup>th</sup> parent night so if it can be coordinated, we will hold one.

There was a concern raised about the door to the annex not working properly. The concern needs to be reported to Bracy for a maintenance order.

A student is interested in starting a Newspaper Club. They will submit the proper paperwork for review at our March meeting.
