Reviewed DIBELS/TRC Testing Proposal. For 16 days 3 times a year – assistants are being pulled to watch classes for testing – which interferes with small group instructions. Looking for ways to cover using specialist and altered schedules to try and limit the amount assistants are pulled is being

considered. Grade level representatives will have to take the proposals to grade levels to get feedback. This will be voted on at a staff meeting. Mrs. Beasley will work with Mrs. Quate to create a version of the proposal that will be easier to understand to share at the next staff meeting. There's no easy way to get this accomplished.

Teaching Your Passion – this is based on a visit at McLeansville Elementary where they have a similar program that occurs every morning to build student interest. Based on the list of skills teachers said they were excited about teaching.
