LATE WORK GRADING POLICY

7th grade students are responsible for completing their assignments in a timely manner. Assignments are due the day they are assigned. Any assignment that is turned in late will result in a 10% deduction. Any missing assignments after the 10th school day after it was assigned will result in a 0. If a student is absent, they have three school days, after returning to school, to make up the missing work. (Extenuating circumstances will be
