- 5) Mr. Zimmerman also asked that he be notified of any other dates staff would like the building to be open on a weekend day. If known early enough the date(s) can be put in the News You Need email.

#### Grade Level Concerns:

- 1) First grade had a parent mention the condition of the gravel drive at the back of the building. Because buses have been using this drive, potholes have developed. Mr. Zimmerman said a request can be submitted to maintenance for gravel to be placed during the summer break. Having signage to alert drivers of children playing in the area was also suggested.
- 2) First grade asked if tardy students can be sent directly to their Specials Class instead of going to their homeroom first. Mr. Zimmerman encouraged the teachers to remind the parents of the start time for Specials, as there is not a staff member in the office to escort students to their Specials class.
- 3) There is a shortage of bus drivers available for field trips. There are no funds available for field trips. Adaptive classrooms should be included in field trips.
