Review of the meeting minutes by E. Carruthers.

I. Attractions Book Fundraiser Update

- a. The fundraiser took six to seven weeks to conclude.
- b. We raised \$3,675.00.
- c. We sold 294 books.
 - i. 56 were sold online
 - ii. 238 were receipted.
- d. We have 158 books that have not been returned.
- e. We had 2 damaged books return.
- f. The amount of time and energy required was great.

II. Chocolate Fundraiser in February

- a. The team needs to consider this fundraiser considering the Attractions fundraiser.
- b. We could ask the representative to come back in December to answer questions.
 - i. SBLT reps will go back to their grade levels and discuss and develop question.
 - ii. This will be similar to the Attractions fundraiser.
 - iii. Can we have parents pre pay for the boxes?
 - iv. Can we have a permission form signed?
 - v. How will this be receipted?
- c. A contract has not been signed, yet, with the World's Finest Chocolate.
- d. Money raised from school fundraisers and school dances will continue to be used to fund additional resources for students in all subject areas.
- e. The team discussed other possibilities
 - i. Have a Spring dance
 - ii. Wear a hat for a \$1
 - iii. SBLT reps will ask their grade levels about ideas for other fundraisers

III. Evidence of Indicator A2.02

Instructional Teams meet for blocks of time (e.g., 4 to 6 hour blocks, once a month; whole days before and after the school year) sufficient to develop and refine units of instruction and review student learning data.

- a. Grade levels and EC are provided a planning day each quarter during which data is reviewed, long range plans are developed, and lesson plans are developed.

- b. Data is reviewed weekly in Data Discussions for grade levels, EC, and Specialists.
- c. Grade levels meet weekly in PLCS and grade level planning meetings to discuss data and lesson planning.
- d. A Staff Retreat provided time for grade levels to refine lesson plans and create norms for grade level planning.
