  - i. \$77,785.18 total Title I money would be available.
- d. Full-time interpreter costs on average \$27,835.87.
  - i. \$49,949.31 Title I money would be available.
  - ii. Currently, our interpreter is funded part-time at our school (Wednesday, Thursday, every other Friday).
  - iii. A full-time interpreter would provide more support in the office.
- e. Other purchases: quarterly planning days, Eureka Math manipulative kits, StoryWorks, Reflex Math site license, agendas
