Review of the meeting minutes by E. Carruthers.

I. Student Council

- a. Calendar was provided.
- b. Students are not consistently coming, but a reminder will be sent to the teachers and the students.

II. Opportunity for expert teachers

- a. These positions are in the highest impacted schools.
- b. Experience is required.
- c. Bonuses will be given to teachers who go to these schools.
- d. There has been a freeze put on all transfers.
- e. The transfer dates have changed and will be updated in May.

III. Staff Allotment Information & Title 1 Budget for 2018-2019

- a. K-3 will have 23 students per classroom next year.
- Projected number of teachers: K-4, 1st grade-4, 2nd grade-3, 3rd grade-3, 4th grade-4, 5th grade-4
- c. Specialists will be here for 5 days.
- d. We will have a Reading Specialist.
- e. CF position is now being completely funded by the district.
- f. We will have 5 TAs, 3 EC Resource Teachers, 2 Adapted EC teacher, 6 EC TA's, 1 Pre-K Teacher, 1 EC Pre-K Teacher, 1 Pre-K TA and 1 EC Pre-K TA.
- g. Mrs. Moore (Data Manager) and Mrs. Jackson (Secretary/Treasurer) will be full time.
- h. We will try to get a full-time interpreter with our Title I budget. If not, we will at least purchase a .5 interpreter position.
- i. This would give us three office staff.
- j. We have been allotted an Assistant Principal for the 2018-2019 school year.
- k. The General Assistant position will be traded in for money, which is what has been done in the past.

- IV. Budget 2018-2019
 - \$22,048 local weighted student formula dollars
 - \$6,624.80 restricted instructional supplies
 - \$34,387 unrestricted instructional supplies
 - \$3,504.80 staff development
 - \$80,721.90 projected Title 1 monies used for:
 - Interpreter
 - Planning Days
 - Student Led Conference materials and food
 - Supplemental materials for Eureka, CKLA, ARC
 - District will pay for the following:
 - 1. \$22,640 literacy materials
 - 2. \$19,788 literacy professional learning
 - 3. \$13,442 Eureka materials
 - 4. \$14,217 math professional learning

V. End-Of-Year Celebrations

- a. There was inconsistency in the nature of the awards last year.
- b. If you are going to award students, every student in the class should get something. Superlatives were given in some classrooms.
- c. Find something good in every student.
- d. Students can receive their Sharktastic certification during grade level/class celebrations.
