

## **SBLT Meeting**

Review of the meeting minutes by E. Carruthers.

**I. Survey Results – SBLT**

Mrs. Jordan reviewed survey results and what pertains to SBLT. She reminded SBLT members to review minutes with their grade levels to ensure the understanding of the minutes and answer questions.

Mrs. Jordan reminded SBLT members to encourage those that they represent to share topics and ideas that would benefit our school. Members will check with grade level about anything from the survey that may need further discussion.

**III. Light It Up Blue (Autism Awareness)**

**IV. School and Grade Level Projections for the 2019-2020**

We are projected to have 609 students at the start of the 2019-2020 school year. Mrs. Jordan should be receiving the teacher allotment numbers soon.

**V. Planning of Simkins' Yard Sale**

The date for our Simkins' Yard Sale has been changed to Saturday, June 1 due to the Go Far Race that is already scheduled for Saturday, May 4.

We will begin advertising on May 2. A flyer will be sent home in Thursday folders. Ms. Siczek will design a flyer for families to advertise the Yard Sale and it will include a registration portion if families would like to register for a table at the yard sale.

For our Simkins Table, we will accept new and gently used items. We cannot accept upholstered furniture. We will store items in our receiving room. The donation window for our table will begin May 3 and end May 24. We will provide a guidelines for what is acceptable to donate and we will also include this on our school's website.

We will have a shift sign-up sheet to help sort items, determine general prices, and to make posters.

We will try to sell popcorn and hotdogs. Kona Ice will be contacted to see if they are available on June 1.

VI. A-Team Proposal

Our Autism Team is working with students and teachers at our school with the help of our Autism specialist, Mary White.

A proposal to provide "A Path" on the hallway outside of Ms. Satterfield's room that will allow students to take a break, and let some energy out, etc. was shared. There is research behind "exercise" in this manner that can help students with autism.

The A-Team will start with this, but for next year, we would like to consider creating "Paths" in other parts of the school inside and outside. Possible areas could be patios outside of Pre-K and Kindergarten, the courtyard patio beside the 2<sup>nd</sup> grade hallway and Ms. Ellison's art classroom, and covered walkways near buses and in the front of the building.

VII. IGNITE Summer Camp

Summer Camp/School will begin June 17 and continue through June 12. There will be 2 Summer Camp/School locations. Bennett College will be the Summer Camp/School location for Greensboro and Emory Wood Baptist Church will be the location for High Point. Summer Camp/School will be held Monday-Friday and the day will begin at 8 AM and end at 6 PM and

Information will be sent home to families of students who qualify for Summer Camp/School. The district is basing numbers right now on DIBELS Middle of the Year Data, but once End of the Year data is collected, we will know which of our students qualify to attend.

VIII. Summer Enrichment Title I Schools Only

Summer Enrichment will be provided for students in 4<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grades who qualify in Title I schools.

Enrichment will be held for students who did not pass their Reading and/or Science EOG. The state requires that enrichment take place after the last day of school. Enrichment will begin June 11-18 from 8:00-2:30. Transportation will be provided. Students will be

reassessed online in Reading & Science on June 13 & 14. The reassessment scores will impact our overall proficiency, but not growth.

Teachers at our school who are interested in taking part in the Summer Enrichment program at our school will be paid \$750. Please let Mrs. Jordan know if you are interested in the Simkins Summer Enrichment program.

- IX. Title I Professional Development Conference  
All Title I schools in our district will need 6-8 certified staff members participate in the GCS Title I Professional Development Conference being held June 17-19. Stipends will be paid to 10-month employees who attend. Members of our SBLT and our ILT are encouraged to attend. Please let Mrs. Jordan know if your are interested in participating.
- X. Teachers who worked on the inclement weather days before the district announced that days will be automatically taken, can put the time that they worked towards the 3 workdays over Spring Break.
