- Were able to move up to 22 tutors because the interventionists were not as much
- Supplies and Materials \$2,697.69 what we used for teacher

This upcoming year (2025 - 2026) - \$141,023.48 (short about \$30,000)

Interventionist - back down to 1

Day time tutor - 1 for 28 weeks mid September - April

After school tutors 10 tutors/12 weeks/ 3 hours per week (cut from this current school year - will be the biggest cut for next year) possibly 2nd - 5th grades

Family and Engagement Budget - \$2,512.11 Proposed that this money be used for transition night at the end of the year

Teacher Allotment - Classes will be possibly a little larger 4 kindergarten, 4 first grade, 4 second grade, 3 third grade, 2 ½ 4th grade, 2 ½ 5th grade

Use an interventionist position for groups for the two halves for 4th

Looks the same as this year

We will only have 4 TAs Alloted for next school years - losing 1 TA position

Down the line - push the Kindergarten TA's to first grade for reading support, Lunches just have a few TA's and maybe push them into second grade
