The meeting commenced at **4:05** in room 114.

Old Business

The School Improvement Plan subcommittee did not have anything to report. Neither did the Climate and Culture and the Discipline subcommittee.

After departmental feedback, the SLT representatives agreed that as long as Performance Matters had the same functionality as GradeCam, then the school should not purchase GradeCam. If Performance Matters does not have the same functionality, we can have GradeCam up and running within 24 hours.

There was considerable discussion concerning the implementation of GoFAR for the 2018-19 school year. A motion was made to vote to increase the number of days from one day a week to three days a week but without a voting body present, the agenda item was tabled until the August meeting.

New Business

Classified staff brought up the dress code and the need for improved enforcement particularly with items such as excessive holes in pants, shirts with holes, and headgear. The Exam Exemption policy was raised. SLT was fine with the current policy.

The 2018-19 school year will start with workdays on August 15, 16, 20, 21, 22, 23, and 24. August 20, 21, and 22 have been mandated by the district for professional development.
