

SEHS SLT Minutes

9.3.2024

The meeting commenced at **8:15am** in room 111.

Copies of the August meeting minutes were reviewed and approved.

Old Business

Madison Muldowney was in attendance to propose a new club, Project 7. This faith-based organization would provide more in-depth Bible study for Southeast students under the advisement of Steven Boone. While this is a nationally recognized organization, SLT agreed that Madison and Mr. Boone needed to touch base with FCA and Campus Life to see if their skillset and ideals could be absorbed by those existing clubs with steady membership.

The subcommittee tasked with analyzing the Teacher Working Conditions Survey Data shared out their observations:

- Overall teachers are happy at Southeast
- There are points of incongruency where while staff are happy here, concerns about trust and transparency are obvious in the data.
- SE teachers have a much higher rate of concern around issues of cheating, fighting amongst students, and drug/tobacco use in comparison to the state and district.
- There is still an ongoing concern where staff perceive that administration as well as their co-workers do not enforce the school rules.

While this subcommittee was not tasked with action steps, the committee did agree that offering choice PD for staff to attend would be a great way to address issues surrounding the lack of differentiated PD.

New Business

The Foreign Language Department asked that SLT consider going back to split block coverage that was the procedure prior to COVID and a stipend for class coverage. SLT wanted each member to speak to the department and tally votes for and against splitting block coverage so that a decision could be made at the October meeting.

The Math Department raised concerns about car rider parents waiting in the front parking lot which causes considerable traffic issues in the front lot. This is also a concern in the back lot. SLT has discussed this in the past and to adequately stop this, supervision would have to be increased considerably starting around 4pm. Administration agreed to communicate car rider expectations in the ConnectEd as well as revisit proper signage to help parents know where they should be.

The English Department requested that SLT consider adding two bells to indicate the end of 1st lunch and the end of 2nd lunch to help push kids into class in a timelier manner. Representatives will speak with their department and bring back feedback for a decision at the October meeting.

Parent and Student Questions / Announcements

Aniya Coleman shared that SGA is gearing up for Homecoming Week as well as getting representatives from each club to join SGA monthly meetings.
