Curriculum Tips

<u>Literacy</u>

READ, READ, READ!

Read at least 30 minutes daily including weekends. Students have begun checking out a classroom book to read at home. Students must return the book before they are able to check out another book. Every student has a "Power Goal" for reading and should continue to work on that goal when reading. Make reading a daily priority.

We are well into our BUGS unit! Your child is becoming an expert on their bug! Pick their brain about their bug and challenge them to help them become even better!

<u>Math</u>

We have begun Module 3. In this module, we are learning multiplication and division of using units of 6, 7, and 8. We have learned how to use tape diagrams, number bonds, and skip counting as strategies to help us multiply, divide, and learn our facts!
