


Mrs. Currin 6th Grade Science @ Kernodle Middle School #DREAM TEAM

o A Designated Science Notebook (used ONLY for science class) & Writing utensil (pencil or pen)




Extra: We do start the year with a cookie lab. I will need volunteers to bring in different types of cookies.

You should complete all science work during class time. For "homework", it is helpful to read over/study your class notes nightly. Doing this will help you prepare for weekly quizzes and tests.

Tutoring:

If you need extra science help free tutoring will be Monday afternoon (3:25-4:00) and Thursday morning 7:15- &:45. Contact me to make sure I meet you at the front of the school for entry "after hours".

Planner & Notebooks:

Your Planner will go with you everywhere. Parents should check planners daily. Your notebook will be your most important Science tool. Put your name on the front. You will use it ALL YEAR. You are to keep ALL your notes handouts etc. in your science notebook. Keep your notebook organized and bring it to class every day.

Daily Warmups:

During the first few minutes of each class you will complete a Science Starter & read/study vocabulary.

Labs/ Activities:

The general rule is HANDS OFF until instructed on procedures. You will be given written and verbal lab instructions that will keep you and your classmates safe. All materials and equipment will only be used as intended. *Any irresponsible* lab behavior or failure to follow lab rules/guidelines will result in your not being able to complete labs – you will only observe or be given a different assignment. You are also responsible for cleaning up your lab station before leaving class, failing to do so will result in a lower grade.
