

## SLT Minutes 08.14.2019

The meeting commenced at **9:05am** in the room 100.

Copies of the June minutes were sent via e-mail and are available on the school website. A motion was made to approve the minutes. The motion passed.

### Old Business

Dr. Seagraves reviewed our school mission, vision and core values.

- **Mission Statement:** Inspire. Education. Tradition. Family
- **Vision:** Inspire students to reach their highest potential by providing a school environment that is rich in rigor and relationships.  
Educate all students to strive for success inside and outside the classroom. Uphold a TRADITION that is built upon strong character, service, family, and community.
- **Core Values:** Inspiration. Education. Tradition. Family. Collaboration. Perseverance. Responsibility.

The by-laws were emailed with the meeting agenda to remind SLT that its purpose is to focus on school improvement planning and implementation. While many agenda items are submitted each month, some items are better handled between the department and Dr. Seagraves. As we move forward, SLT agenda items will focus on school improvement.

The Attendance Committee met this summer and proposed a new attendance policy. This policy will require students to make-up time after their 3<sup>rd</sup> block absence in any course. Along with deterrents for absences, there will be incentives for perfect block attendance. SLT voted to approve this policy. ### New Business

Dr. Seagraves shared an update concerning OneCard implementation. With no software in the building to support its use or additional information, SLT decided to table this discussion until the September meeting.

Dr. Seagraves shared information about the Educator's Handbook. The online system will replace paper referrals in the district. Teachers should claim their accounts prior to the training's administration will be holding August 18, 19 and 20. As a reminder, in many situations, bumping a student to ISS is a student's consequence that may not always require a referral.

With the district adding 5 minutes to the start of each day, it was decided that these 5 extra minutes remain in 1<sup>st</sup> block as it did last year. The bell schedule will remain the same with school starting at 8:50.

Understanding that the PSAT will be administered October 16, SLT agreed to administer the PreACT on November 6.
