Instruction:

The week of May 30 is an instructional and make-up testing week for students at Ferndale Middle School. Students are expected to arrive no earlier than 9:20 AM. Please do not drop your scholar off before this time, as we must ensure they are safely able to enter the building with appropriate supervision.

Assessment:

This week at FMS, we will administer make-up EOY Testing for all students, including our remote students. For your information, our testing dates are as follows:

Please do not pick up your student before the designated end time for testing each day. Please note that each day we will run

Monday, May 31 - Memorial Day. No students, teachers, or staff will be in the building and the school building is closed.

Tuesday, June 1 - Make-up testing for all in-person students – all subjects. Make-up testing for Reading and Science for Remote Learners. Grade 8 Students taking the Science EOG on this day need to bring their device.

Wednesday, June 2 - Asynchronous remote learning day for in-person students. Math Testing for ALL Remote students Grade 6-8 (all courses).

Thursday, June 3 - Make-up day for testing and the last day of school year 20-21 for students.

Friday, June 4 - Teacher workday and no students are in the building.

Summer school for Ferndale Middle School will take place at High Point Central High School.

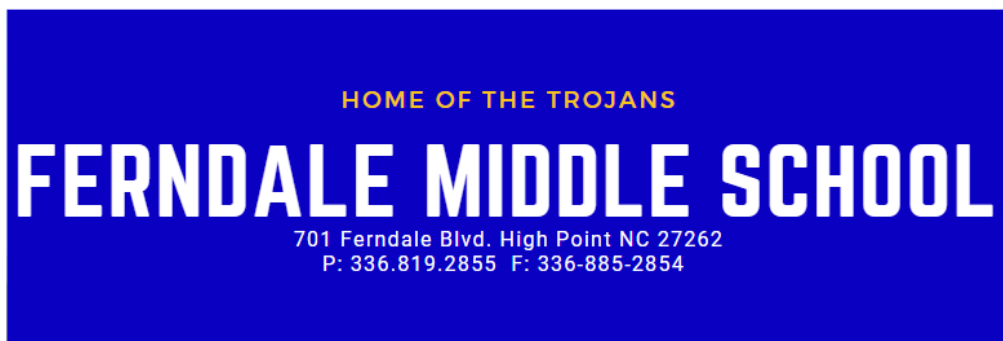
School Activities:
