

## SEHS SLT Minutes 10.1.2024

The meeting commenced at **8:15am** in room 111.

Copies of the September meeting minutes were reviewed and approved.

### **Old Business**

SLT representatives shared their departmental votes for adding bells to indicate the end of 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> lunch with the majority of the school voting to add the bells. The bells will begin October 2.

SLT representatives shared their departmental votes for splitting coverage, and this was approved. This will start Monday, October 7 with Mr. Scott splitting the coverage using the batting order as of October 7. SLT will reevaluate this at the November meeting.

### **New Business**

SLT needs to elect a new secretary. With no one volunteering, this was tabled until November.

The National Honor Society will need new advisors for the 2025-26 school year. Ideally, these new advisors would work alongside Mrs. Mitcham this year. SLT will discuss this again at the November meeting.

The Math Department raised concerns over the length of the morning announcements. Moving forward, announcements will need start and end dates.

CTE asked about increasing locker use in the school. SLT agreed that this needed to continue to be at students' request.

CTE has been getting student requests to print work for other teachers. This is becoming a problem, so SLT agreed that if a teacher required printed work, they needed to offer their own process for students to print the work. SLT wanted teachers to be reminded that submissions in Canvas can be downloaded all at once for quick printing.

CTE also raised concerns about the increased number of tasks that 3<sup>rd</sup> block teachers have been asked to do such as device distribution, homecoming voting, etc. Ultimately, Scott asked teachers to reflect on the amount of instructional time being used on instruction rather than being lost to schoolwide needs. Additionally, 3<sup>rd</sup> block is used as it is the block with the most students on campus.

A concern was raised about students who drop their 4<sup>th</sup> block not leaving campus. When teachers are aware of students who are not leaving or do not have transportation, please communicate that with an administrator.

Questyn Hinton proposed a new club around knitting and quilting. While SLT did not have time to discuss this further, Shearin conducted a virtual vote and the club was approved.
