

Scholarships (January 2021)

Lenoir-Rhyne University offers a Teaching Scholars scholarship program for students planning to teach in N.C. public schools. Priority consideration will be given to students applying by **January 10**, but they encourage students to apply for admissions and for the scholarship immediately, as spaces for this scholarship award are limited.

The I Have A Dream Scholarship is one award worth \$1,500. Submit an online response of 250 words or less to the following prompt: *"We want to know—what do you dream about? The Aubrey Lee Brooks Foundation will be available beginning Dec. 7. It offers up to \$12,000 annually for students who plan to enroll next year at North Carolina State University, UNC-Chapel Hill, or UNC-Greensboro. This foundation also offers a one-time computer allowance and funds during summer sessions for study abroad, internship, and/or research opportunities. Applicants must demonstrate financial need and complete the FAFSA. Applicants are expected to have participated in extracurricular activities, volunteered in their community, and/or been regularly employed. The application is available online at www.CFNC.org/brooks. All application materials must be received by the foundation by **January 31**.

The Jackie Robinson Foundation awards scholarships to outstanding high school seniors in a minority group who plan to earn a four-year degree from an accredited college/university. The Jason Christopher James Memorial Scholarship is a \$5,000 award that will be given to a student interested in politics, international relations, traveling, and studying/living abroad. Applications are available at www.cfqq.org. Deadline to apply is **Feb. 5**.

The Florence Kidder Memorial Scholarship is a \$3,000 scholarship awarded to a N.C. senior who plans to attend a college or university in North Carolina. One runner-up will receive a \$1,000 scholarship. Recipients will be selected on the basis of the merit of an essay on the assigned topic, plus character and scholastic record and need. The N.C. SECU "People Helping People" Scholarship is a \$10,000 scholarship (\$2,500 per year for 4 years). Applicant must be a senior at North Carolina public high school, be SECU members or eligible for membership through a parent/guardian, accepted to attend one of the 16 public UNC system schools next year as a full-time

undergraduate, have demonstrated scholastic achievement with a 2.5 unweighted GPA or higher, be a U.S. citizen, a resident of North Carolina, and eligible for in-state tuition, have demonstrated leadership, excellence of character, integrity, and community involvement, and demonstrate financial need and must file the FAFSA as a part of the application. The application was emailed to all seniors on December 21. Let Mrs. Graves know if you need another copy. Completed applications must be received by Mrs. Graves via email by **February 22, 2021**.

“Sweet and Simple” Scholarship: one recipient nationally will be selected to receive a \$1,500 scholarship. Submit an online short written response (250 words or less) for the scholarship topic *“Not every gift has to be expensive or extravagant. In fact, sometimes it is the sweet and simple things that make a real difference in our lives.
