- a. *Emerging School of Character (Auman)*
 - i. Received feedback and will apply again next year
 - ii. Applying for a “promising practice” for our Hawk’s Nest. This will give us more formal documentation of for the school award.
- b. *Data (Ellis and Bowie)*
 - i. Attendance
 - 1. Tier 1 (out about once month), Tier 2 (2x a month), Tier 3 (Chronic Absences)
 - 2. Counselors, Admin, and Social Worker are working with Tier 3 families to address these issues
 - 3. Tier 1 and Tier 2 absences are being addressed in 3, 6, 10-day absent letters
 - 4. Daily calls when a student is absent
 - 5. SOAR committee and Student Ambassadors will brainstorm possible ways to address the importance of coming to school for 2019-2020
 - ii. Discipline

1. Aug to Dec data
 2. 32 incidents are about 16 students for 8th grade
 3. Bus referrals dramatically down from last year at this same time
- iii. Interim Data
 1. Comparative Data
 2. 8th grade math after-school tutoring—We will target this group of students with additional days of after-school tutoring for 10 weeks—March-May. Invitations will be sent to these students
 3. Achievement Gap Data—looking for ways to show the number of students in the gap instead of just the interim assessment test average of our minority students

 1. Lunch, library checkout, athletic events and bus check in will all be tracked through students' One Card
 2. Students will be required to wear IDs; GCS has determined discipline procedures for students who do not wear badges
